
NATIONAL TRAILS DAY, JUNE 7, 2014 RIDE THE "M" BUS TO THE TRAILS!



you to celebrate National Trails Day by taking a city bus to go for a fun and healthy hike on our wonderful foothill trails. We will catch the 10:20 "M" Bus at Sheridan Station, near the plaza, and get off on Camino de Cruz Blanca to walk to the trailhead. It is also possible to catch the same "M" bus at the Railyard Depot (Guadalupe St.) at 10:25. Those who drive to this event can find parking at the St. John's College Trailhead and walk up the trail along Camino de Cruz Blanca.

We will meet at the Dorothy Stewart Trailhead at about 11:00. After the $\frac{1}{2}$ mile "warm-up" hike from the bus stop to Dorothy Stewart Trailhead, events will include:

- 11:00 a.m.: Celebration / Proclamation of National Trails Day at Dorothy Stewart Trailhead, with healthy snacks courtesy of the Santa Fe Conservation Trust.
- 11:05 a.m.: Guided Hike on the Dorothy Stewart Trail (easy to moderate level hike), with interpretation on plant life by Karen Denison of Outspire Hiking and Snowshoeing.

The first "M" Bus back downtown after the event will pass though on Camino de Cruz Blanca at about 12:45 p.m. and arrive back at Sheridan Station at 1:04 p.m. The busses run hourly and so anyone running behind schedule for the trip out or back can catch the next bus.

Please wear suitable shoes and bring water and snacks for the hike.
